The Great Blackwater Swim

Thank you for registering for the 2nd 'Great Blackwater Swim'. This is a fast downriver swim of 3.5kms starting at Castlehyde House, home to Mr. Michael Flatley, of Riverdance and Lord of the Dance.

Some details on the day:

→ Parking

- Map below details 2 public car parks available
- Please park all cars in Fermoy and not out at start venue, we have a bus to get everyone out to the start

→ Registration

- Register between 8.30 and 9.45am at Fermoy Rowing Club, Ashe Quay
- Please come early and don't leave until last minute, we have over 200 competitors and need to bus everyone out to Castlehyde house for an 11am start. Bus will be taking participants out from 8.45am
- Limited registrations available on the day. If someone wants to register on the day please come early to do so. Increased cost of €40 to register on the day.
- At registration everyone will have a number written on their hand which they will need to call out at the finish line

→ Changing Facilities:

- Changing facilities available at Fermoy Rowing Club or change at the start location and enjoy the surroundings and river front location of Castlehyde House, we will have a van at the start to bring bags etc back

→ Bus to Start Location

- We have a 55 seater bus bringing competitors to the start location, this will have to make at least 4 round trips and will be running from 8.45am. We will need a full bus to leave at 8.45am to get everyone out to start on time.
- Bus will be leaving from Hanley's shop at the south side of bridge as seen on map.
- Please register early and go out to the start as soon as registered and enjoy the surroundings of Castlehyde house, smashing location
- Race Briefing will take place on the bus on the way out

→ Start Location (Small competitor Bags)

- We will have 2 vans at the start location that competitors can put small bags in and we will bring them back to Fermoy.
- One van will have a red sign for bags of participants 1 to 99. The second van will have a White sign for competitors 100+.
- They will be waiting at the Rowing Club for collection.
- Everyone will get a tag at registration to attach to their bags, please check your number is correct on it.
- Your bags and property are in safe hands with our volunteers but please avoid bringing items that may be damaged in transport as Blackwater Triathlon Club will not accept liability.

→ Finish

- Finish is at Fermoy Rowing Club slip
- A white Blackwater Triathlon Club buoy will be out as a marker, swim around this, keeping it on your right and fully into the slip and call your number
- Refreshments available at the finish line
